Format of Article

BTEJ is inviting original and field work based research articles from the scholars and researchers around the globe. *BTEJ* encourages the researchers to submit papers as per the following format:

Title of the Paper/article

-The title should be specific which clearly indicates the research problem. The title of the paper should not exceed 20 words.

-Abstract (Bangla and English. Abstract in English must be placed first)

-The abstract should provide a complete synopsis of the research paper and should introduce the topic and the specific research questions/objectives, provide a statement regarding methodology, methods, and tools for data collection, data processing approach, the respondents/participants, and the major results/findings of the study. If the researcher(s) likes, they can include the implications. The abstract must be in between 200 and 300 words.

1. Introduction

The introduction begins by introducing the broad overall topic and providing basic background information of the study. It then narrows down to the specific research question(s) relating to the topic under study. Every section may have subsections. It provides the purpose and the rationale for the study. Introduction should contain around 500 words.

2. Literature Review

The purpose of the literature review is to describe the recent important research and it must be related to the research problem. It should include all relevant findings from credible sources, such as academic books, peer-reviewed journal articles, university websites, etc. It should contain around 1000 words. The researchers must tell the readers how the reviewed literature is related to their research.

3. Research Methodology

This section will describe the research design and methods used to conduct the study. Methodology (quantitative, qualitative, mixed method), methods (survey, interview, FGD/FGI, etc.), and the data collection tools (questionnaire, observation checklist, observation protocol, interview schedule, etc.), the participants, participants selection criteria, data collection and analysis procedures should be clearly mentioned in this section. It should contain around 1000 words.

4. Findings and Discussion

This section will describe the findings of the study. Findings that directly emerged from the study and related to the research questions/objectives should be placed here. Graphs and tables should only be used when there is too much data to efficiently include within the text.

The last paragraph must contain the researchers' own analysis and interpretations of the data. Literature reviewed earlier should/can be related here in this section in support of or oppose to what the researcher(s) is saying. The researchers must make it clear what the data are saying or what the data mean. It should contain around 2200 words.

5. Recommendations (Optional)

In this section, the researcher(s) may put forward some recommendations based on findings of the study. Recommendations are optional because they (recommendations) are inbuilt in the findings.

6. Conclusion

This section should summarize the whole study in brief. No new idea(s) can be included here. However, the implications, how the limitations were overcome, new areas for further study, etc. can be stated briefly. It should contain around 300 words.

References

In this section, the author should give a list of works cited in the paper. Researchers must follow the APA Referencing style (7th edition, <https://apastyle.apa.org/instructional-aids/reference-guide.pdf>).

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Information for Submission:

- Submission deadline: 30th September, 2021
- Articles must be in English
- Word limit: 5000 words excluding references and abstract
- Main heading of the article should be attached at the center of the page and sub-headings should be left aligned.
- Times New Roman in 12 points font size with 1.5 spaces is to be followed. Pagination should be one inch on all sides on an A4 paper.
- Articles/Papers formatting, citation, and referencing: The APA Style, 7th Edition.
- The author's name, affiliation and email address should be on a separate page (first page), and the title (maximum 20 words), key words (4 – 6) and the article should start from the second page.
- Tables, charts, graphs should be numbered and clearly visible in black and white (follow APA 7th edition referencing style)
- If there is any acknowledgement or declaration, it should be mentioned before the list of references.
- Author will be responsible for plagiarism.
- The manuscript must be original and that must not have been published or submitted to any other journal.
- The article should be in MS Word file form with 15-20 references.
